

RESEARCHING A CURE

The Fisher Center for Alzheimer's Research at The Rockefeller University, directed by Nobel laureate Dr. Paul Greengard, recent accomplishments:

- The discovery of a previously unknown protein in the brain that stimulates the production of beta-amyloid, known to contribute to the cause of Alzheimer's disease. New treatments are expected.
- Developing a breakthrough technique that will accelerate Alzheimer's research by allowing scientists to compare thousands of genes at once instead of one at a time.
